Established in 2005 & starting its denim production operation in early 2008, Envoy Textiles Limited is the 1st denim mill with rope dyeing technology in Bangladesh. It is also the country's largest denim mill with annual production capacity of 50 million yards.

The 1st denim mill in the world to receive LEED Platinum certificate in 2016

- Our denim production capacity is 4.5 million yards per month, 54 million yards per year

We produce a wide range of denim fabrics weighing from 4.25oz to 15oz, in 100% cotton and a variety of blends, with diversified finishing effects, best suited to our customer's preference. We also produce high quality, innovative eco-friendly fabric products.

Speed Collections: these are our fast running items for which certain amount of inventory is maintained to assure quick response to customers' order.

Vintage Collections: thanks to the expertise of our R&D team and our state-of-the-art equipment, we are able to offer our customers the vintage collections featuring the spirit of denim.

Sustainable Collections: these collections are developed from sustainable sources such as organic cotton, BCI cotton, natural dye materials, and are made under sustainable process, such as laser or ozone washing.

CLEAN PRODUCTION

Environmental concern:

Aside from ISO 14001 policy implementation, we also take several other types of environmental measures. Examples of such environmental measures includes our Effluent Treatment Plant, as well as our compliance with various standards such as PaCT, HiGG Index Fem 3.0, BEPI and CPI2 (Carbon Performance Improvement Initiative), to manage the use of water, energy and chemicals, CO2 emission and waste discharge in a sustainable manner, to create a cleaner production platform.

We use liquid indigo and strictly follow ZDHC chemical guidelines in our dyeing process to minimize the ecological impacts and to protect the health and safety of both our employees and our consumers.

Equipped with the latest Jeanologia laser machine, our E-lab project is our new footprint in pursuing impactful sustainability



RESPONSIBLE SOURCING

Sustainable raw material sourcing:

We engage in various projects such as Yess Project, etc. and comply with various standards such as GOTS5.0 & OCS 2.0 standards, to ensure that our raw materials are sustainably sourced.

Cotton:

We procure cotton only from reliable and traceable sources. The proportion of BCI cotton, CMIA cotton, organic cotton and other sustainable cotton is gaining higher precedence in our cotton consumption, with 36% in year 2017 to 71% in 2018.

Sustainable fibers:

Sustainable fibers are regular items used in our mill, such as Tencel®, recycled fibers.
